Workshop started with inauguration session on 22rd July 2019 in presence of Dr. Sukhanandi, Deputy Director (Nursing & MH), Dr. Narayan Gaonkar, Health Specialist (UNICEF Gujarat), Dr. Himanshu Joshi (HoD, Paediatrics, GMERS Gandhinagar) and Ms. Inderjeet Kaur from Fernandez Foundation, Hyderabad.

First half of the first day was technical session followed by three and half days of hands on training in the labour room of GMERS Hospital Gandhinagar. Dr. Arun Singh, National Advisor for RBSK program visited the training and provided his guidance to the participants on third day of training.

On 29" July, 2019 every organization drew up their plan to provide Respectful Maternity Care to women coming to their labour rooms. Detailed discussion was facilitated by Dr. Bipin Nayak HoD Ob-Gy, GMERS Gandhinagar and Dr. Apurva Ratnu (Maternal Health Consultant) from UNICEF Gujarat.






